Notice of Race (NoR)

Version 1 - 21.12.2018

The notation [DP] in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the international jury, be less than disqualification.

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

Organizing Authority

The event is organized by Sailing club Pirat Portorož and the Slovenian Sailing Federation.

1. Rules

- 1.1 Sailing Point Easter Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions will apply:
 - WS Regulation 20
- 1.3 The following prescriptions of Slovenian Sailing Federation will apply for Slovenian sailors only:
 - Pravilnik o oglaševanju
 - Pravilnik o registracijah in prestopih tekmovalcev
- 1.4 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are changed as follows:
 - 1.4 (a) The first sentence of RRS 40 is deleted and replaced by: "Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD) according to class rule 4.2 (a), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing."
 - 1.4 (b) Add to the preamble of Part 4, after 'racing': ", except RRS 40 as amended by NoR 1.3 (a).
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. [NP] [DP] Advertising

- 2.1. Sailor advertising is permitted on the hull as per World Sailing Regulation 20.3.2 but as restricted by class rule 2.8.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.



3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Sailing Point Easter Regatta is open to all competitors of Optimist Class. All competitors, registered in their national Sailing Associations, can take part in the Sailing Point Easter Regatta. It is mandatory for all competitors to have a coach or support person on Sailing Point Easter Regatta. Entries for competitors and coaches shall be done online via the regatta website <http://www.klub-pirat.si/prijava-regata?regata=23> and paid to be considered as valid. Online entry opens on 1st January 2019 and will last until Sunday, 7th April 2019 or until 500 participants have been reached, whatever is first. The Organizing Committee has the right to accept entries received after the entry deadline.

- 3.7. No entry will be considered as valid without payment of the required Entry fee.

4. Fees and training camp

- 4.1. For competitors, completing the online entry procedure before Sunday, 7 April 2019, the entry fee is 50 € per boat. For competitors, entered after 7 April 2019, late entry fee 80 € applies which shall be paid in cash at registration.

- 4.2. Participants can join the training camp a week before or after Sailing Point Easter Regatta, which includes boat storage and wash off water. Candidates shall enter Regatta Office to get their training camp labels. Training camp fee is 5 € per day to be paid in cash at arrival in the Regatta Office.

- 4.3. Any changes in the participant's name, gender, sail number, birth date and/or the representing club name are possible at registration on Thursday, 18 April 2019, from 16:00 to 20:00. Later changes are subject to a correction fee 20€ to be paid in cash at the Regatta Office.

- 4.4. Competitors can request the cancellation on their entry by sending the Organizing Committee an e-mail on address info@klub-pirat.si. In case such request is made before 7 April 2019 and is accepted by the OC, the entry fee will be reimbursed after deduction of an administrative fee of 5 €. No entry fee refund will be made after 7 April 2019.

5. Registration procedure

- 5.1. Registration of competitors shall be made only by the corresponding coaches or team leaders.

- 5.2. The following documents shall be present at registration:

a) Fulfilled and signed Parental Authorization for Sailor, available on website http://www.klub-pirat.si/si/file/download/1168_7a041e17651/Parental%20authorization.pdf

b) Sailors original third party insurance covering not less than 1.000.000 € (NoR 17);

c) Original supporting boat insurance;

d) Coaches shall provide the list of sailors under their responsibility. The form is available on website http://www.klub-pirat.si/si/file/download/1169_40b3f641575/PRIJAVA%20REGATNE%20SKUPINE.pdf

6. Format of racing

- 6.1. Boats will be divided into fleets, as far as possible with the same number of boats.

- 6.2. The allocation to fleets will be done by the Race Committee on 18 April after the close of registration.

- 6.3. Fleets will sail an open series, followed by a final series.

- 6.4. In the open series, boats will be re-assigned to fleets after each day of racing.

- 6.5. If minimum two races have been completed until the end of the second scheduled racing day, the last racing day will be the final series.

- 6.6. An opening series will not count, until all fleets in the opening series have completed the same number of races

- 6.7. Final series: Boats will be assigned to final series fleets (Gold, Silver, Bronze, Emerald,...) on the basis of their rank in the open series.

- 6.8. In the final series, boats do not need to sail the same number of races.



7. Program

7.1. Schedule

7.2. Sailing Point Easter Regatta consists of 9 races. No more than 4 races may be sailed each day.

7.3. The scheduled time for the first warning signal on each racing day is at 11:00.

7.4. On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

8. [NP] [DP] Measurement

8.1. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

8.2. Boat may be subject to inspection at any time during the event.

9. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available on the website and/or at registration.

10. Venue

The regatta will be in Piran Bay.

11. Course

The course will be outer loop trapezoid with the finish line at the end of second windward leg.

12. Penalty System

12.1. Appendix P will apply

12.2. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

13. Scoring

13.1. 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be total of the race scores.

13.3. When from 4 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14. [DP] Support boats

14.1. Team and Support boat drivers shall register their boats. The form is a part of an online entry on the event website :

14.2. Each support boat shall prominently display a numbered flag. The identification flags are mandatory and will be supplied by the Organising Authority against payment of a



refundable deposit of €20 paid in cash upon registration at the Regatta Office. No other individual team support boats shall be used. It is the intention of this provision that each sailor shall have a coach and a support boat on the course.

- 14.3. Coaches are encouraged to use a VHF radio. Radios will not be provided and coaches should bring their own.

15. Prizes

- 15.1. Prizes will be awarded to:

- the 20 best-placed competitors overall
- three best-placed girl competitors
- three best placed cadet boy competitors (born 2008 or later),
- three best placed cadet girl competitors (born 2008 or later),

- 15.2. The Sailing Point Perpetual Trophy will be awarded.

Sailing Point Perpetual Trophy is donated by main sponsor, Sailing Point, Specialised Sailing Store. The Trophy is perpetual and will be awarded to the best ranked club in the event. The team consists of top four ranked sailors from the same club. Clubs will be ranked according to the lowest sum of final points of its top four ranked sailors in the rankings and the Sailing Point Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the club, with the lowest total points. The Trophy is made of marble and will remain in the organizing club for security reasons.

16. Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after regatta.

17. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.000.000€ per event or the equivalent.

18. Television and Photographers Rights

Competitors give absolute right and permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes
