NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority of the event is Sailing Club Pirat Portorož in cooperation with Slovenian Sailing Federation.

The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2. If there is any conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after Wednesday, 26 June 2024 on the event website and on the official online notice board.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The event is open to all 420 class boats.
- 3.2. All competitors shall be members of Slovenian Sailing Federation or any other World Sailing Member National Authority.
- 3.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form available on the event website and paying the appropriate entry fee by **Tuesday, 25 June 2024**.
- 3.4. All online entries shall be personally confirmed in the race office not later than Friday 28 June 2024 until 11:00 .
- 3.5. The Organizing Committee has the right to accept entries received after the entry deadline.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fee is

- 4.3. Late entry fee will be charged to all boats, who will enter after **25 June 2024**.
- 4.4. Late entry fee could be paid in cash only.

5. [NP] [DP] ADVERTISING

- 5.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 5.2. From the second racing day, competitors ranked first, second and third in the series at the beginning of each day shall wear on top of their clothing yellow, blue and red bibs, respectively while racing that day. The bibs will be provided by the organizing authority.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. Schedule of races

Date	Time	Description	Races per day
28 June	14:00	Racing (open series)	3
29 June	12:00	Racing (open series)	3
30 June	12:00	Racing (final series)	3

- 6.2. No more than 4 races may be sailed each day.
- 6.3. The scheduled time for the warning signal for the first race each day is 12:00, except on Friday, 28 June 2024, when the scheduled time for the warning signal is at 14:00.
- 6.4. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

7. [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the club, regatta harbour and the position of the racing areas.
- 8.2. One racing area will be used for all fleets.
- 8.3. Racing areas will be the same as the one used on 2024 420 European Championship.

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be trapezoid or windward-leeward.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 10.2. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.



11. [NP] SCORING

- 11.1. Nine races are scheduled and the event will be valid if at least two races will be finished.
- 11.2. (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. [NP] [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 12.1. Team and support vessel drivers shall register their vessels via online formular or at the Race Office before the start of the event. The registrations shall include sail numbers of boats, they are supporting.
- 12.2. Support vessels shall be marked with numbered flags, supplied by Organising Authority.
- 12.3. Refundable deposit for a flag is 20,00 EUR and will be given back while returning the flag.
- 12.4. Coaches are encouraged to use a VHF radio. Radios will not be provided and coaches should bring their own.
- 12.5. Fuel for support vessels is available on MOL petrol station in Marina Portorož. It is forbidden to refuel the support vessels in club area.

13. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boats's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boats handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

14. [NP] [DP] INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.000.000,00 EUR per event or the equivalent.
Proof of insurance shall be provided upon registration.

15. DATA PROTECTION

By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity to make, use, and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the event, and of all of his or her material related to the event, without compensation.

16. PRIZES

- 16.1. Prizes will be awarded to teams in each class:
- first three teams overall
 - first three teams in Woman category



- first three teams in Mixed category
- first three teams in U17 category
